### Side effects of data disruption



Reduced employee productivity



Delay in product or service development



Inability to provide essential services



Decline in revenue



Its Costly

**HUMAN ERROR:** An accidental document (or M365 workspace) deletion, device theft or spilled liquids on a laptop



**ADMIN ERROR:** Admins could mistakenly alter permissions to a workspace or fail to deploy proper retention settings

**MALICIOUS INSIDERS:** Disgruntled employees may delete, corrupt or remove access to important data



**CYBERCRIME:** Threats such as ransomware put data and finances at risk by holding stolen information hostage
